THE SUNRISE POLICE DEPARTMENT HAS NOTIFIED US THAT SUNRISE RESIDENTS HAVE BEEN TARGETED WITH AN IDENTITY SCAM WHICH IS BRINGING SUSPECTS TO THEIR RESIDENCES. INCIDENTS HAVE BEEN REPORTED WHERE VICTIMS ARE RECEIVING PHONE CALLS FROM PERSONS PRESENTING THEMSELVES AS FRAUD INVESTIGATORS OR EMPLOYEES OF A FINANCIAL

INSTITUTION. THE PERSON WILL EXPLAIN THAT THERE IS FRAUDULENT ACTIVITY ON THE VICTIMS CARD AND THE CHIP NEEDS TO BE REPLACED.

FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS MAY CONTACT YOU IN REGARDS TO FRAUDULENT ACTIVITY HOWEVER THEY WILL NEVER ASK YOU FOR PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION AND THIS INFORMATION SHOULD NEVER BE GIVEN OUT TO ANYONE THAT CALLS YOU. IF YOU BELIEVE THERE MAY BE FRAUD ON ANY PERSONAL ACCOUNTS YOU SHOULD CONTACT YOUR BANK DIRECTLY. NEVER PROVIDE INFORMATION OVER THE PHONE AND DO NOT ALLOW ANYONE TO COME TO YOUR RESIDENCE. IF THIS OCCURS OR IF YOU HAVE ANY INFORMATION CONTACT SUNRISE POLICE 954-764-4357.

#### ALSO PLEASE REMEMBER NOT TO LEAVE VALUABLES IN YOUR CAR; ALWAYS LOCK YOUR CAR EVEN IF YOU WILL ONLY BE GONE FOR A MOMENT.



We are in need of volunteers for the compliance committee; the time commitment is no more than 1 hour per month @ 6pm. Please contact the office if you are interested.




Another reminder Welleby is no longer mailing coupon books; if there is a balance on your account you will receive a statement prior to each quarter.



OWNERS MAY ELECT TO PROVIDE FOR RESERVE ACCOUNTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 720.303(6), FLORIDA STATUTES, UPON OBTAINING THE APPROVAL OF A MAJORITY OF THE TOTAL VOTING INTERESTS OF THE ASSOCIATION BY VOTE OF THE MEMBERS AT A MEETING OR BY WRITTEN CONSENT.



Hurricane season is June 1st through November 30<sup>th</sup>. Hurricane hazards come in many forms, including storm surge, high winds, tornadoes, and flooding. This means it is important to have a plan that includes all of these hazards.

When a tropical storm or hurricane watch is issued, be sure to clear your yard of loose objects such as bicycles, lawn furniture, lawn ornaments, garbage cans, toys, etc. Be prepared... learn locations of official shelters; get cash; fill your car with gas; check emergency equipment such as generators, flashlights, radios and cell phone batteries; purchase water or clean containers for fresh drinking water; purchase food that will keep such as canned items; refill prescription drugs; put important documents in watertight containers or bags; make arrangements for your pets; review and be sure to have your homeowners insurance policies handy; purchase wood or prepare to install or close you hurricane panels or shutters.

The City of Sunrise has prepared a Hurricane Evacuation plan. Raccoons are urban animals and encounters are very common. Raccoons are smart, curious, and like other wildlife in Florida, there is really no way to simply keep them away. However, there are some steps that can be taken:

- •Don't leave pet food outside overnight.
- •Make sure that outdoor tables and chairs (or anything else outside) do not have even a crumb on them when you retire for the night.
- •Store trash indoors or outside in a container that can be locked (or place some type of heavy object such as a brick on the top) until trash is picked up. Keep any exterior trash containers clean and free of smell and store upside down when they are empty.
- •Make sure all trash placed into the dumpster is securely sealed. If you have meat or other smelly food in the trash, double bag it and add a little bleach or strong cleanser on the bag outside before depositing it in the trash.
- •As raccoons seek shelter as well as food, do not allow landscape material or grass to grow excessively in the rear yard and keep your area debris free.

The association is not responsible to handle nuisance wildlife; if you have a nuisance animal contact Critter Control (this is not a free service) at 754-701-1615.

Single family homeowners are responsible for maintenance (cleaning and repair) of the sidewalks abutting the home, including sidewalks that may be on the side of or behind the home, even on the other side of a fence. Mildewed, lifted or damaged sidewalks pose a tripping hazard that can result in bodily harm to persons walking on them, which could result in law suits to both the owner and the association. Welleby staff is continuously inspecting for damaged or dirty sidewalks, however, each owner should inspect and take corrective action prior to being notified by the association.

Please inspect the sidewalk abutting your home. If repairs are needed and your sidewalk is in a city right of way, the city of Sunrise has a program to help owners with repairs at a reduced cost. Contact the city at 954-572-2344 for more information. If your streets are private you will have to obtain your own contractor to complete the repairs.




